Taxes: Issued yearly in June. Discounts for early payment:

We bill out utilities monthly the first week of every month for the previous month consumption. Payment is due the last day of the month, after which 3.75% interest is charged. Water supply is from Wakaw from SaskWater pipeline.

All new water accounts require a 150.00 deposit on account. This amount will be applied to your final bill, or refunded if not balance is owed upon closing the account.

Pet Licences – Cats and dogs are required to be licenced in the village. Tags are \$10.00/animal and can be purchased at the village office.

Garbage Pickup is weekly on Tuesday mornings between 8am and 12 pm. Garbage tags can be purchased at the village office for \$3.50, and are required for pickup. Maximum weight per bag is 44 lbs, larger bags (109L + will require two tags. Residents place bins/bags on the front of their lots by the street so garbage can be picked up easily.

We have blue recycling bins on the South West corner of town for cardboard, tin cans and paper. Unfortunately plastics are not recycled at this time as per directives from REACT.

Trees/leaves/branches/grass clippings can be taken to our dump which is on the SouthWest corner of the community just across the train tracks. No garbage- only organic waste from yards. Free compost in spring for residents.
